What a journey it has been! As I reflect back on 2009, it would be easy to have feelings of disappointment and frustration. I think we can all agree the economy has provided us more stress than usual. On one hand, I can say that it has. He will continue with chemotherapy and has eight more sessions ending in March/ April. He must continue these to eliminate any chance of dormant or floating cells in his body.
